



Audi FIS Ski World Cup St. Moritz Accreditation Guidelines

The Organizing Committee of the Ski World Cup St. Moritz is happy to welcome you again this year. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, strict protection and safety measures are in place for both Super-G races. These measures that have to be observed at all times.

All accredited persons will be pre-assigned to an individual colour group / zone in order to prevent individual groups from mixing with each other. The assigned zone may not be left during the entire event. The LOC reserves the right to expel persons who do not adhere to the safety measures from the event area and to withdraw their accreditation.

Each group is defined by a colour as follows:


Red	All persons who are travelling with or are in direct contact with the World Cup team. In particular, these are athletes (incl. forerunners), coaches, support staff, service staff, the closest management of the athletes, FIS, startline judges, camera crews in the start house, finish area and in the leader box (close proximity to athletes).
Blue	All persons involved in the organisation on the track, in the start/finish area or at other locations of the event: volunteers, race officials, emergency organisations, civil defence, army, contractors.
Yellow	All media professionals such as host broadcasters, journalists and reporters from television, newspapers, online portals and radio, photographers, technicians.

Important:

Prior to accreditation, all those involved in the Ski World Cup St. Moritz will have to sign a declaration stating that they have read and understood the basic Safety Concept and the relevant colour appendix. Accreditations will only be handed out personally. For this occasion, please bring the signed colour appendix with you (download from the above-mentioned website).

After receiving accreditation, you will – on a daily basis - receive some questions relating to your health via e-mail / SMS / WhatsApp. You must answer these questions without fail in order to be granted access to the event area (this also applies to the use of mountain railways / cable cars). To ensure contact tracing, you will have to log in / out at Salastrains by means of accreditation. Should you NOT have previously answered the questions relating to health, access will be denied.
