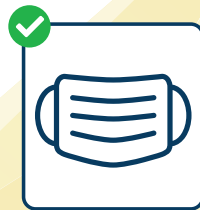

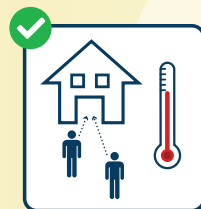

- In the interest of sport and with respect to the OC and the entire population, all those present commit themselves to implementing and complying with the necessary measures in a spirit of solidarity and with a high degree of self-responsibility.
- Only those who are completely healthy, have no previous illnesses or disease/Covid-19 symptoms nor have been in contact with sick persons may take part in the event. All persons must comply with the specific requirements of the FOPH.
- All accredited persons will be assigned in advance of the event to their respective colour group/zone in order to prevent individual groups from mixing. The assigned zone may not be left for the entire duration of the event.
- Prior to the event and to be granted accreditation all persons will have to fill in a questionnaire relating to their health to be found in the relevant colour appendices. Accredited persons will receive these questions daily online and will have to answer them in full in order to be granted access to the event site.
- In order to ensure contact tracing, all persons will have to log in / out at the finish area Salastrains by means of accreditation. Access will be granted only to those having answered the questions relating to their health (also applies to users of mountain railways / cable cars).
